SAFETY REGULATIONS/DISPLAY CODE OF CONDUCT FOR YOUR CAR/VEHICLE AT ANY LHCC EVENT.

- Vehicles must have no above ground 'visible to the visitor' external rusting surfaces (if in doubt, apply primer paint).
- There must be no sharp edges on bumpers, door handles, lamps, mirrors, exhausts, etc. (particularly where loose chrome is decaying).
- Ignition keys must be removed by the owner from the ignition switch during static display.
- Members assembling gazebos/sail flags must be aware they are to be secured to the ground or secured under a vehicle wheel.
- The instructions of event marshals are to be followed and they must be treated by members with courtesy and respect.
- The owner of any vehicle not complying with our Display Code of Conduct will be asked to re-move it from LHCC displays and may be subject to being removed from the club membership as per club rules..
